Yet, he knew how to take his revenge when the time came, cramming to prepare for vocational training certificates or competitive exams, multiplying training courses and internships when the stakes, in his eyes, were worth it. Starting with his exemplary career at the Jaÿsinia botanical garden, which began in June 1983 under the best auspices. For this young septimontain from a rural background, who already had a passion for bees, but who very early on - under his father's guidance - began working on cycles and motorbikes, the retirement of the Jaÿsinia municipal employee, the aptly-named Narcisse Dechavassine, was a great opportunity to seize.

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
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A GREAT HISTORY

From the Middle Ages onwards, renowned stonemasons settled in this small glacial valley with its seven mountains, nestling in the heart of a magnificent mountain environment, and built a unique architectural heritage. Today, Samoëns is a modern village with the allure of yesteryear: typical Savoyard houses, solid stone dwellings, large authentic farms and chalets share a wide, flat valley with an exceptional natural environment. A lively and bustling village, Samoëns is full of real treasures and invites lovers of heritage and old buildings to listen to History speak...


Witnesses of History

MUST SEE

A central square and a large linden tree

In the southern villages, there is always a central square, the place of life par excellence. There is also a plane tree, providing shade for passersby and bearing witness to the history of the village. In Samoëns, a preserved village in Haute-Savoie, we find this atmosphere thanks to a beautiful tree, a large linden tree planted in the central square of the village in 1435 and still in great shape (its 9.50m trunk circumference testifies to this). If it could speak, this large linden tree would tell the story of the appearance of the name Samoëns, from the 12th century, the multiplication of chapels, oratories and other buildings built by farmers, which have become **stonemasons** by necessity, the birth of an Alpine Botanical Garden with 2,400 varieties of plants, born from the donation of Marie-Louise Cognacq-Jaÿ, a former shepherdess of the village who became a key figure in Paris, the arrival of services and modernity... It would be the witness of a centuries-old and fascinating history!





The Frahans

The Frahans, stonemasons of Samoëns practice a craft that goes back a long way. In 1659, they transformed their professional group into a religious brotherhood called the "Confrérie des Quatre Couronnés" (Brotherhood of the Four Crowned), in homage to four Christian martyr saints. These saints had refused to build an idol statue for the Roman Emperor Diocletian. They can be seen depicted in a stained-glass window in the choir of the Church of Our Lady of the Assumption in Samoëns.



TO KNOW

Stonemasons...

At the bend in every street and every path, in the heart of the village, as in the surrounding area, there remain testimonies of extraordinary men who built Samoëns: **the stonemasons. The "Frahans"** were in fact men of the valley. From the 15th century, to supplement their income from traditional agricultural activity, they began to work with stone and **limestone**, very present in the region. Their reputation quickly spread **around the world.** Called to the biggest construction sites of Vauban or Napoleon Bonaparte, they went as far as Poland and Louisiana!

Samoëns, at the heart of their talent, keeps in memory an infinite number of **chapels**, **oratories**, mausoleums, **houses** and other buildings built by these men with incredible know-how. The Frahans brotherhood still exists today under the name of "**Société des Maçons**" Thanks to a handful of enthusiasts who have preserved the know-how of their elders. You can still meet some of them at a workshop and discover their story during the Wednesday morning guided tour.



...and an authentic and preserved rural life Between agriculture livestock farming and

Between agriculture, livestock farming and stone-cutting, Samoëns was built on a foundation of traditional of **rural activities**. Today, although tourism has taken the place of the stonemasons, there are still many carpenters, foresters, stockbreeders and farmers. They are the very soul of the village; they are the ones who keep traditions alive, the ones who enable the village to retain the authenticity that makes it such a fabulous place to live and holiday! "Made in Samoëns!" You'll be able to discover the dairy cooperative, the farms and the many mountain pastures.



DID YOU KNOW

Originally, seven mountains

The seven mountains or mountain pastures surrounding the village gave their name to the inhabitants of Samoëns from 1438: **the Septimontains** Living year-round in a flat-bottomed valley at an altitude of 720 m, they have forged a close relationship with the benevolent mountains that surround them. This is evidenced by the town's coat of arms, representing the seven mountains, topped with a fir tree.



The mountain pastures

The seven mountain pastures, or seven mountains, surrounding the village of

Samoëns and having given their name to the inhabitants, the Septimontains, are: Fréterolle, Chardonnière, Vigny, Cuidex, La Vullie, Bostan, as well as Oddaz and Folly, often grouped together.


TENDRE COEUR DE PIERRE: A TENDER HEART OF STONE

"Born in Samoëns with a trowel and a hammer in his hand," Pierre Bianco seems driven by a perpetual desire to share and explain. At over eighty years old, built like a rock, the man who was also, from 1959 until recently, a ski instructor, enjoys contact. Teaching has always captivated him and, whatever the age of the person he's talking to and the subject, he enjoys, as with children, testing their responsiveness and reflexes. Which, in some cases, can make you lose track and be unsettling... but satisfies his mischievous and curious side.

He then continues, delighted, his demonstration and never forgets to say in the preamble: "The individual is composed of three points: the head which thinks, the hand which is the most beautiful servant of the spirit, which transforms and then inside the individual, there is a heart or there is no heart. The rest is nonsense."

Once he gets going, there's no stopping him when he recounts a significant episode in his career, such as his experience as a monitor with a disabled child for fifteen years and everything that this real challenge brought him. With great calm and his soft voice, he remains imperturbable to any question and will answer later, much later... when he does not move on to another story!





LA JAŸSINIA

Samoëns, a gnand ganden

Samoëns has a stunning botanical garden that showcases the rich flora of the area. Car-

ved into the side of a hill in the very heart of the village, it is the result of an exceptional destiny: that of Marie-Louise Jay, a young shepherdess born in Samoëns at the end of the 18th century who came to the capital at the age of 15 to seek her fortune!

"À vous les studios Cognacq-Jay", this expression pronounced by Léon Zitrone marked the world of television, but also that of Samoëns. By marrying Ernest Cognacq, met in Paris, and founding with him La Samaritaine, the most famous department store in the capital, Marie-Louise Jaÿ became a famous and extremely wealthy lady. Remembering her childhood years and very attached to the hill on which she grazed her goats, Madame Cognacq-Jaÿ decided to create a botanical garden there, a testament to her desire to preserve the beauty of the place. This is the birth, in 1906, of "la Jaÿsinia".

TO DO

Visit the village: **Discovering Samoëns' heritage**

From the fountain to the old covered market La Grenette, in front of the Château de la Tour or under the roots of the big linden tree, escape behind the stones of the village.


The life of the old town and its evolution are intertwined with the history of visitors. During the guided tour of the historical and architectural heritage of the town of Samoëns, you will delve into the culture of the famous stonemasons.

Visit the chapels by electric bike

Discover Samoëns in a different way, by electric bike (EAB), during guided tours supervised by a cycling instructor. In a friendly atmosphere, set off to discover the village for 2.5 hours, in small groups of 3 to 9 people, and explore its chapels and other hidden treasures on two wheels.

Chapels of Samoëns

The nine chapels of Samoëns, most of which date from the 17th century, tell the story of the Alps and local know-how. The oldest, at Le Bérouze, dates from the 15th century, and the most recent, at Les Allamands, from the 19th. Their baroque

Le Bois aux Dames in Samoëns is a multi-purpose centre that combines cultural, sporting, and leisure activities in the heart of an exceptional natural setting. This site hosts a variety of events, such as exhibitions, shows, and concerts, and boasts modern facilities suitable for all generations.

Le Bois aux Dames Space

Cultural, sports and conference centre (426 seats / 1,100 standing). They have played at the Bois aux Dames: Le Peuple de l'Herbe, Wishbone Ash, Rhoda Scott, Anne Roumanoff, Izia, Yvan Le Bolloc'h, The Gladiators, The Congos, Opéra-Studio de Genève...

Guided tours on the Little Train but not only...

A must-see attraction for those curious about the village's heritage history, **the Septitrain** takes generations on a journey of discovery of local symbols. From the Church, a testament to the stone-masons' expertise, to other architectural treasures (fountain, granary, etc.), travelers travel through time.

Exhibitions

Explore three places where art and mountains meet:

1. The old stables of the castle

This exceptional vaulted room hosts the works of painters, sculptors and creators in a unique setting.

2. The Barbara Thollot Art Gallery

Discover artistic photographs of the Alps, sculptures, and a bookstore dedicated to mountain stories. On the program: Seasonal exhibitions - Guest artists each month - Workshops, conferences and signings.

3. The François Désarnod media library

In collaboration with the Criou Livres association, the media library offers a variety of exhibitions to enrich the artistic and literary experience.

Three locations, one passion: revealing the beauty of the mountains.



Explore 30 years of secrets of the farmers at the Clos Parchet Ecomuseum

Clos Parchet is open from mid-April to the end of October

Located at an altitude of 1,000 m on the slopes of the Adret, this former **19th-century** farmhouse has been home to the Clos Parchet Ecomuseum since 1994. Restored and furnished, it immerses visitors in the traditional life of yesteryear. More than **2,000 tools** illustrate life at the time, work in the fields and stonemasonry.

In the heart of the village

Stroll through the historic village of Samoëns and discover the traces of stonemasons as you wander through its narrow streets. Don't miss the must-see attractions: La Grenette, the church, and the famous linden tree : Le Gros Tilleul.

A gourmet experience not to be missed

Discover the châtrée soup, an essential specialty of Samoëns!

This traditional dish combines stale bread, local tomme cheese and onion soup, offering a tasty tribute to the flavors of the region.

THE SEPTIMONTAINS

Claude Genevois

CHOO-CHOO

In Samoëns, he is nicknamed "Choo-Choo". Claude Genevois, owner and driver of the Little Tourist Train on tires which winds through the streets of the villages of Samoëns and Les Vallons, always delights children of all ages.

Originally from Oisans, settled with his family in Les Deux Alpes, Claude followed his wife, eager to seize a professional opportunity in Samoëns in 2000. At the time, the Little Tourist Train, which began operating in 1993, was dormant due to a lack of a driver. For Claude, who was passionate about independence at this turning point in his career, history must be written under the sign of freedom. He bought the famous Little Red Train and created his company in 2003. He subsequently acquired a second, all-white and more powerful one. Retired but still active and happy today at the wheel of his Septitrain, Claude takes legitimate pride in welcoming passengers delighted to take this "vintage and collector" means of transport that is part of the Samoëns postcard. There are only about ten of these in circulation in the entire Haute-Savoie region. In all objectivity, Claude finds that "coming to Samoëns without taking a ride on the Septitrain is like visiting Paris without seeing the Eiffel Tower!" Not wrong!

The paths to freedom

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

A FAVORITE

The Afghan walk

To escape the intensity of everyday life, connecting with nature is one of the most effective ways to forget your problems.. The goal is to **synchronize the rhythm of one's steps with one's breathing** for a regenerative and anti-stress walk. This meditative experience allows practitioners to intensely feel the benefits of nature on themselves.



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TO RECHARGE YOUR BATTERIES

Sensory walking

This discipline allows you to reconnect with the environment and with youreself. Step by step and in rhythm, the forest trails open up to those who take the time to contemplate and listen to what the **nature has to offer.** Alone or in a group, sensory walking allows us to discover the environment around us with its shapes, textures, colors, sounds, and smells. Nature thus offers a plenitude that allows us to intensely recharge our batteries.

TOWARDS WELL-BEING

Nordic walking

Between sport and well-being, Nordic walking allows you to enjoy the benefits of nature while exercising in an exceptional setting. This discipline, very popular in Scandinavian countries, can be practiced in all seasons. Halfway between a hike and a jog, this fast walk takes in some of the most beautiful spots in the Giffre mountains around Samoëns.

Enjoy a healthy and balanced meal in one of the village restaurants or opt for a picnic in the great outdoors.






Relax and refocus with a yoga session, ideal for loosening the body and calming the mind. A perfect moment of serenity for the afternoon.

Wellness areas


To complement these activities, Samoëns has a number of wellness centres for those who want to relax in peace and quiet on a more individual basis. On the program: sauna, hammam, jacuzzi, swimming pool... free access upon reservation of a massage.

Stretching, breathing, relaxation, Yoga brings greater self-knowledge. Hatha Yoga, according to the Eva Ruchpaul technique, is a gentle method that stretches muscles and joints by listening to your abilities. The **breathing** is conscious and omnipresent throughout the entire session. The postures and associated breathing allow for rest of the mind, relaxation of the body and exceptional inner calm at the end of the lesson.

TO PURIFY

Mobile Nordic sauna

Mobile sauna made of red cedar wood, fueled by a wood stove, which travels throughout the Giffre Valley. Two options are available: a shared sauna session to strengthen immunity and community, or a private session for 1 to 6 people. Each session includes access to a changing room, a relaxation area, and cold showers.

Here, nature becomes an adventure partner, attracting experienced athletes and curious explorers in search of new discoveries.



TO FLY AWAY Paragliding

Samoëns is one of the most popular paragliding spots in the region. Thanks to its location in the valley and consistently favourable wind conditions, Samoëns is the **ideal place to enjoy your first paragliding experience**, contemplating the beauty of the majestic landscapes of the Haut-Giffre valley from the air.

WITH CURIOSITY

Caving

Going underground to better understand the formation of our Earth is both a physical activity and, above all, an educational one. In addition, Samoëns is one of the most renowned caving spots in France, with the Jean Bernard chasm, one of the **deepest chasms in the world** (-1,600m). Other sites are accessible to all the family.





TO TRY

Ride differently on an E-Fatscoot

Discover a brand new, unusual and totally ecological activity: the E-Fatscoot, **an all-terrain electric scooter** for a different kind of ride! Get off the beaten track and come try an original and environmentally friendly experience. Fun, playful, and easy to use, follow the guide and discover the beauty of Samoëns' landscapes thanks to the all-terrain electric scooter. An activity for the whole family.

TO ADMIRE

Fly over the mountains by helicopter

Take off for an emotional first flight **above the Giffre valley.** Admire breathtaking panoramas and marvel at the beauty of the mountains seen from the sky. An unforgettable experience, as magical for young and old alike!



SURPASS YOURSELF

The via ferrata

Midway **between hiking and climbing**, the via ferrata allows you to climb safely on the cliffs overlooking the Giffre. Routes equipped with cables, metal rungs, footbridges or even rope bridges will lead the most daring to the summits where the views over the valley are breathtaking.

UNUSUAL

Survivalism, learning to survive in the mountains

Discover the mountain differently: **in survival mode**, by experiencing a true immersion. A hike for all audiences to discover the mountain and its secrets, but also how to preserve this unique nature. Participants will learn the techniques for surviving in the mountains: finding their way, orienting themselves, protecting themselves from the cold, making a fire, hydrating properly, eating, using equipment, building an igloo in winter, etc. An adventure as close to nature as possible to discover the mountain as you have never seen it before!

Mountain equipment

In the mountains, it is essential to be well-equipped: layered clothing, windbreaker, gloves and a hat for the cold, comfortable hiking shoes, and a bag with water. Also consider a first aid kit, map or GPS, headlamp, and a camera to capture your moments.

This 14-kilometre blue run links Flaine and Sixt-Fer-à-Cheval, with a total height difference of 1,700 metres. The originality and fundamental advantage of this slope obviously lies in the fact that the skier can cover the run without, at any time, needing to take a ski lift. In addition to the pleasure of skiing without constraints, this slope is above all a real breath of fresh air and nature. With a single stroke of the ski, you descend from the summit of the Grandes Platières to the banks of the Giffre, admiring in turn its majesty Mont Blanc, the Désert de Platé, Lake Gers, the Tenneverge, the Ruan and a multitude of frozen waterfalls. Keep your eyes wide open...

At an altitude of 1,692 metres, it offers steep climbs and spectacular views of the surrounding mountains, making it an unforgettable experience for road cyclists.

The environment is the key to a healthy lifestyle. The resort-village of Samoëns understands this and is taking a number of measures to preserve it, with one major aim: to maintain this beautiful "Nature Destination".

Some examples of actions taken


- **10 public charging** points in various car parks for recharging electric vehicles.

Energy side

The ice skating rink and the Bois aux Dames building are powered by geothermal energy. All public lighting is now fitted with LEDs, and certain sectors will soon be regulated by clocks or presence detectors to optimise energy consumption.

Gentle route "Au fil du Giffre"

"Au fil du Giffre": a green, non-motorized way through the heart of the valley. This peaceful itinerary links **Sixt-Fer-à-Cheval to Taninges**, offering a unique opportunity to discover the area on foot, snowshoes, bike or horseback, in the heart of a green and serene setting.





Natural spaces with Natura 2000

Samoëns, a preserved territory: A third of its surface area is classified Natura 2000, guaranteeing the protection of exceptional flora and fauna. This label distinguishes its unique habitats and remarkable species.

The environmental observatory of the Grand Massif

Since 2008, the Grand Massif area has had an **environmental observatory** covering **4,219 hectares** in five municipalities. It records local biodiversity and monitors environmental developments to better preserve **sensitive areas**.

The Grand Massif ski area, including Samoëns, is aiming for sustainable management by 2030, with three objectives: **zero net carbon, positive biodiversity** and **zero waste**. Its actions include a plan to reduce **energy consumption, protect sensitive environments,** restore **ecosystems** and raise **awareness of water pollution**.
