To get started, nothing beats a day of skiing to kick off your stay at the 4th largest ski area in France! Ideal for both children and adults who are new to skiing, Samoëns 1600's beginner area is a reassuring spot to progress without stress.

As soon as you arrive via the Grand Massif Express, which connects the village to the slopes in 10 minutes, you'll find yourself in the beginner area without needing to climb any stairs. Served by 7 ski lifts and equipped with restaurants and snack bars, you can enjoy relaxing in the sun while keeping an eye on your children. The fun zone features the "Septi Snake" on a green slope—a gentle slalom for learning and having fun, with three freestyle modules along-side the piste to try out some tricks! A conveyor belt has also been installed for students using the ski lifts—ideal for avoiding the anxiety of the first drag lifts and easing into skiing smoothly.

The Grand Massif is one of the largest ski areas in the French Alps. With a wide variety of slopes, everyone can enjoy the thrills of skiing, snowboarding, paret, snooc, and more, regardless of their skill level.



In the heart of winter, the water temperature in the mountains ranges between -5 and 0°C, creating ideal conditions for ice swimming. The positive effects of a cold-water swim on physical and mental health are numerous: improved blood circulation, boosted immune system, reduced stress, intense feelings of well-being, and more. A frosty dip that leaves no one indifferent!

It's worth noting that the resort has hosted the Ice Swimming World Championships on multiple occasions.

The mountains are the source of the water cycle. The precipitation they receive feeds rivers that flow to our seas and oceans. 80 to 90% of the waste found in the seas originates from land. Please keep and sort your waste at the base of the resort where bins are provided.

What are these birds?

The Black Grouse and the Ptarmigan live year-round on the ski area. In winter, these species find refuge in powder snow areas, which are also popular with skiers and snowshoers.

These species are known as umbrella species: "species whose habitat is broad enough to ensure the protection of other species in the same community."

DAY 7

THE FARM "LE CRIOU": FRESH FARM PRODUCTS

The family-run mountain cattle farm produces milk and makes its fresh cheeses exclusively from its own herd. This herd is fed with forage and grass from the farm's meadows. With two partners, the farm has a herd of 50 Abondance dairy cows and the necessary replacements (50 calves and heifers).

"The milk produced is largely delivered to the fruitière (dairy cooperative) in Samoëns to be processed into AOP Reblochon cheese. The rest is processed on the farm throughout the year into white cheese, fresh cheeses, and aged cheeses," explain the operators. The cheeses are sold directly at the farm and are also available in some local shops or featured on the menus of certain restaurants in Samoëns and the surrounding area.

THE FARM "CROËS CANAILLES":

PRODUCTION AND SALE OF FRESH CHEESES

This family-run farm produces and sells cheeses from its Hérens cattle, a breed typical of the mountain region. "We make Tommes, Tommettes, Croestin, Mountain Cheese (similar to raclette), as well as milk, butter, cream, and occasionally sérac," the operators explain. They also offer eggs from their hens, charcuterie, sausages, and dried Hérens meat. A rich selection to delight the palates of fans of farm products.

PRODUCTION AND SALE OF CHEESE ON THE FARM

Another family-run farm to explore is where cheeses made from cow and goat milk are produced and sold. Here, you can find tomme, raclette cheese, sérac, fresh cheeses, and yogurts. La Ferme des Cimes is open for visits year-round by appointment, and the operators will explain their working methods and share their passion with you. These tours conclude with a delightful tasting of products accompanied by accordion music. You can also visit the farm after a stroll, enjoying homemade hot chocolates, coffees, and juices from local producers, as well as cakes, toasts, and other farm products.
